All outer doors kept open during service. Congregation only stand at Gloria, Gospel and Creed. The peace is not shared. Single-use orders of service and pew sheets are to be taken away after the service.	L	Sidespersons encouraged to enforce facemask wearing and social distancing

Transmission from lectern	Readers/Intercessors	L	Lectern socially-distanced in placement. Readers and intercessors not to touch lectern. Lectern cleaned between services	L	
Unsupervised children moving in Church	Congregation	M	Children to stay with parents at all times. One or two children selected to read intercessions/lesson and serve at family Eucharist keeping social distance.	L	Parents kept informed of current practice and encouraged back to church safely
Music within church	Worship leaders	M	When singing is permitted choir take seat 2m apart before service begins, Facemasks worn between singing.	L	Briefing to be made each week by Director of Music
Distribution of Communion	Congregation	M	Wafers kept covered during service. Priest to use hand-sanitizer and gloves before distributing. Priest to wear facemask during distribution. Priest to stand in the sanctuary sacrament is given single file to the congregation. Social distancing to be maintained throughout. The chalice is not shared. One way system in place for distribution .	L	Clear direction from sidespeople.
Coffee after worship	Congregation	L	No refreshments served after church	L	
Residual contamination	Infection passing between services	M	Cleaning after every service using Dettol all in one spray – effective as per website	L
